Town and Community Project Updates

Community/Senior Center:

The Town recently purchased the former Grange building located at 215 2nd St. and obtained grant funding, and other donations, to renovate this property into a new Community/Senior Center! This project serves to preserve a part of Kersey's history, while providing a more ideal location for Kersey's Seniors Inc. and offer other services to community groups. The Town expects to break ground on the renovation later this fall!

Centennial Trail:

In 2017, the Town was awarded a transportation alternatives grant through CDOT to fund the construction of a trail between north and south Kersey with sections running along the Latham canal. The project is expected to last until 2020 with much work happening prior to actual construction on the trail. Upon completion, the trail will serve as a great way for pedestrians and other users to travel more safely across the railroad tracks, Latham canal and through Town!

Town and Community Project Updates, cont...

Town Center/Streetscape:

Also in 2017 the Town acquired 446 1st St. along with the acquisition of 440 1st St. in 2018. at the corner of 1st St. and Trumbull St. The goal is to create a Town Center involving three separate phases all intended to help revitalize downtown Kersey, prepare us for the growing future and aid in the High Plains Library District with their expansion in Town. Phase One involves the construction of a new Town Hall and public parking area; Phase Two involves construction of a new museum/cultural center; and Phase Three involves streetscaping efforts for all of 1st St downtown! The Town currently is applying for grant funding to help with Phase One and should have a decision by December 2018!

Derek Prescott Memorial Basketball Court:

This summer the Derek Prescott Foundation along with tremendous donations from LEC Construction, and many other area and local companies, completed the construction of a new outdoor basketball court at Centennial Park!
